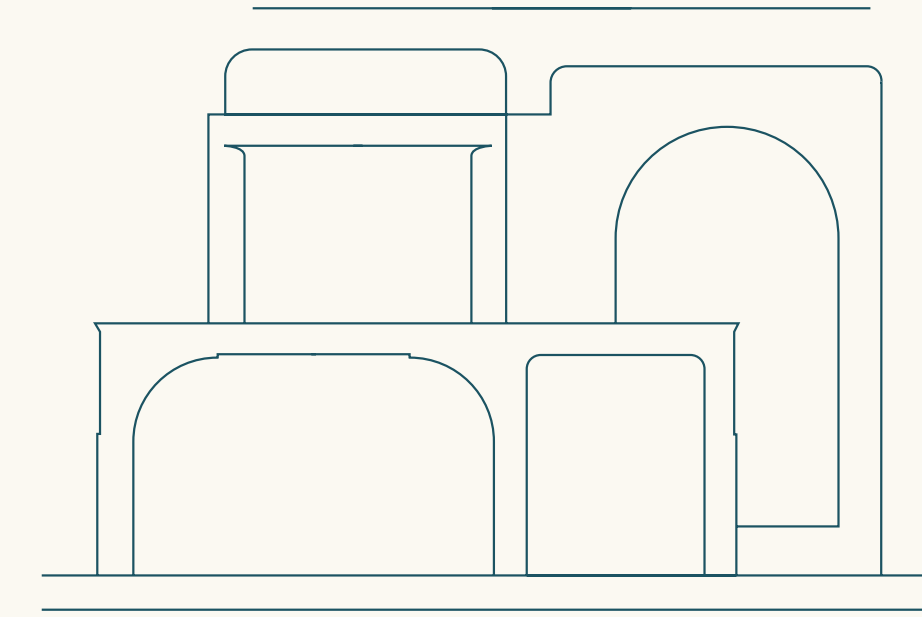

Siddarth believes homes should age gracefully, growing richer with memories, not outdated by trends. The neighbourhoods he imagines feel human in scale, never overwhelming, never crowded. Every villa, every path, every corner is chosen to hold life, not just fill space.

Wasn't Chosen for Luxury.

A home isn't about the first photograph. It's about the ten-thousandth morning.

Mediterranean design is an act of patience. The arches aren't for decoration. It's distributing weight. Inviting light. Creating flow between rooms, between moments, between people. The stone isn't imported for status. It's chosen because it breathes with the seasons. The Mediterranean theme makes you earn affection, slowly, deeply, and permanently.



Six Villa Clusters

Instead of building in rows, Fiora offers six villa clusters, small neighbourhoods within the larger community, each with its own personality. Positioned to capture light, views, and connections, some nestle by the skating rink, and a few overlook the swimming pool. Every villa and cluster nurtures family, friendship, and lasting memories.

Fiora is intentionally limited to just 72 villas, not for exclusivity, but to preserve intimacy. With fewer homes, faces become familiar. 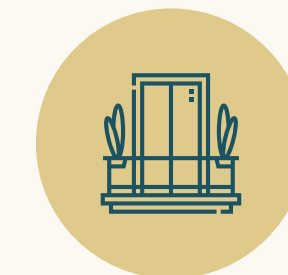

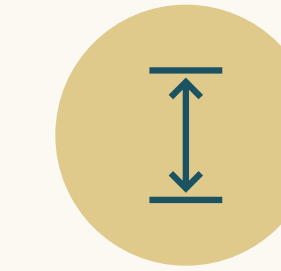

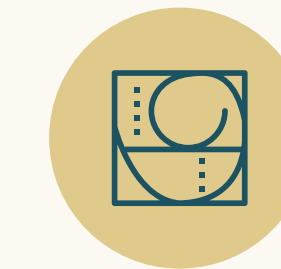
Double-Height Drawing Rooms

This Chakra is strengthened by spaces that support physical energy and personal progress through consistent daily use.

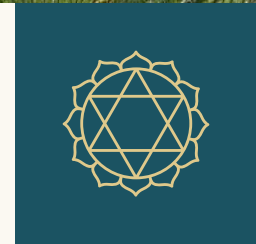
Outdoor Gym

This Chakra opens in spaces where people gather, celebrate, and share experiences comfortably.

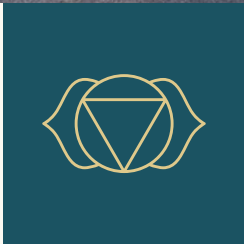
2 Banquet Halls

Library

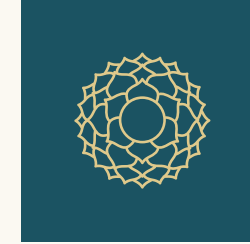
A calm reading space that offers silence, focus, and a break from daily distractions within the community.

Elevated open spaces designed to slow the mind, invite fresh air, and create moments of pause under open skies.

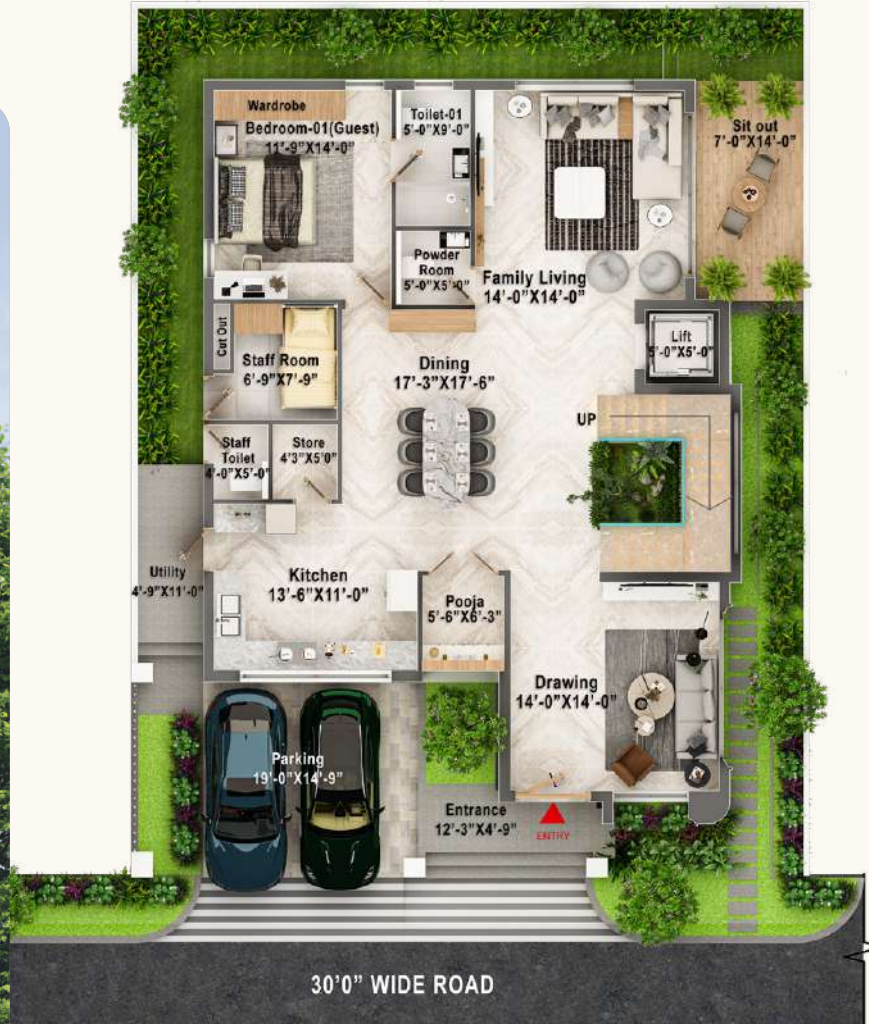

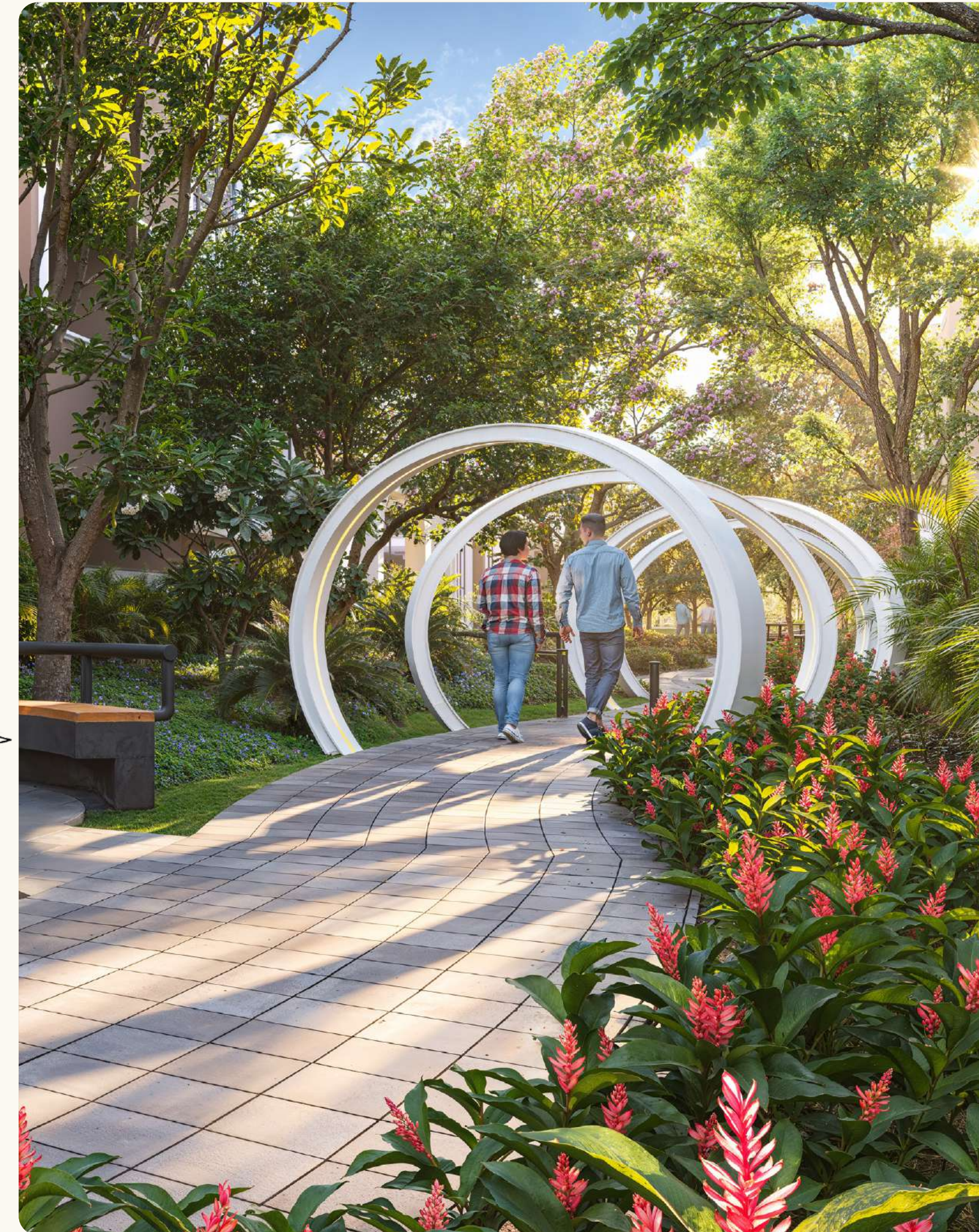

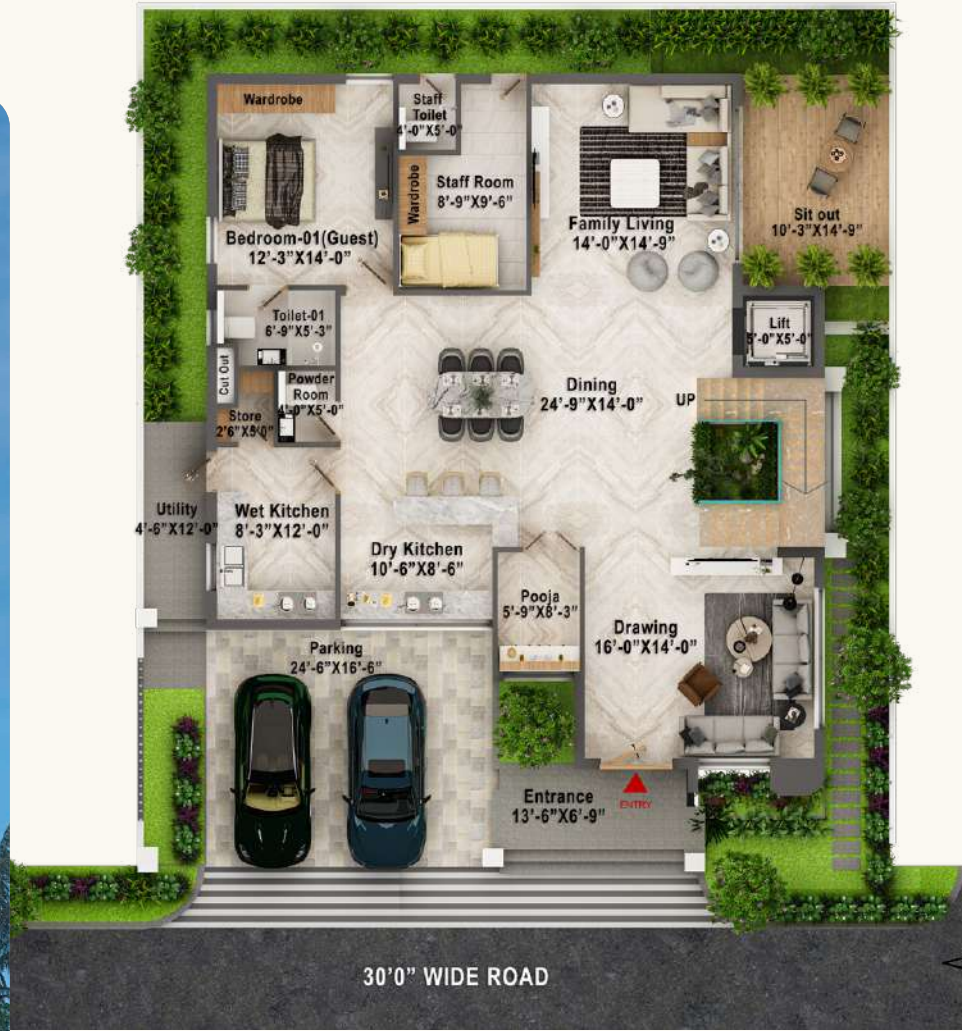

The Club Fiora

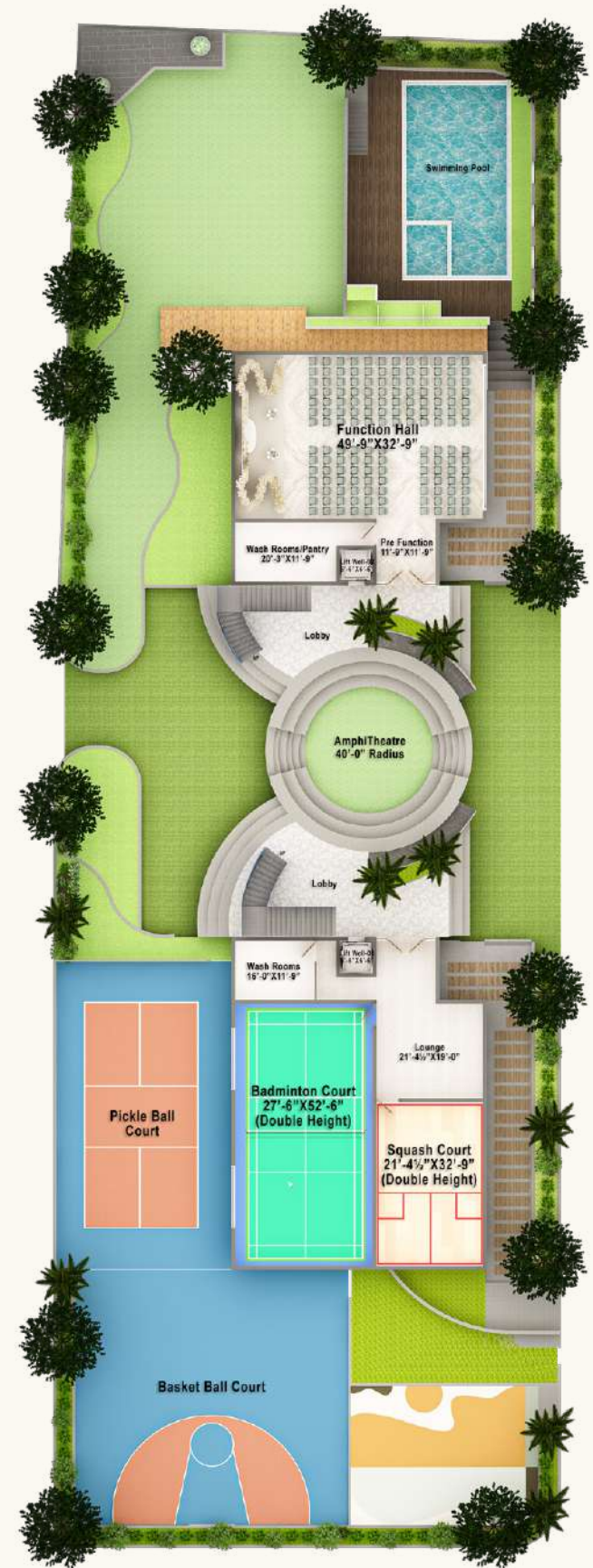
The 2 Wings clubhouse at Fiora is not designed to impress at first glance. It is designed to be returned to, again and again.
